

**INSTRUCTIONS FOR CANDIDATE
FOR
NRTI UG & PG ENTRANCE TEST 2020-21**

Date: 7th September, 2020

1. No request for change in Examination Date/Session/Centre will be considered/entertained under any circumstances post application closure date.
2. **The Candidate must bring his/her Admit Card at the respective examination centre.** The candidate is also required to bring one of the Photo Identifications in original viz. Voter ID / Driving License / PAN Card / Passport / Aadhar Card etc for verification. The identity of the candidate will be matched with the original proof. For verification purposes, candidate must bring 2 identical recent passport size photographs. No candidate shall be permitted in the examination centre without carrying Admit Card and original ID Proof under any circumstances.
3. Candidates are strictly advised not to bring any kind of Electronic Gadgets, Calculator - separate or with Wrist Watch, Tablets, Bluetooth Device, any type of Mobile Phones, or any other instrument, Books, Slide Rules, Foot Rules, Note Books, Written Notes, etc. which may assist him/her in cheating during the conduct of examination and these will not be allowed in the examination centre. Any candidate who is found copying, receiving, giving assistance or using unfair means during the exam will be disqualified and NRTI will not be responsible for the cancellation of candidature at any stage of admission process.
4. Please retain this Admit Card carefully for future records as the same is required to be produced at the time of joining the institute.
5. User ID and Password for the online examination will be provided to the candidate 10 minutes before commencement of the examination at his/her respective seat.
6. Candidates are requested to report at the examination centre positively at least 2 hours before the commencement of the online examination. **The main gate will be closed 45 Minutes before the commencement of the examination.** No late comer will be allowed entry into the examination centre.
7. The medium of the online question paper is English.
8. Your candidature for the examination is 'purely on provisional' basis subject to checking of eligibility criteria at the time of selection. In the event of any

information or part of it being found false or incorrect before or after the exam, your candidature will stand to be cancelled and required action will be taken.

9. In case the candidate receives more than one admit card for single course due to multiple registrations by him/her, the candidate is directed to handover the admit card which is/are not required, to the room invigilator at the time of examination. The candidate will be allowed to appear in the examination for one course at one time only.
10. Candidate is also advised to read the General Instructions carefully for ONLINE examination as enclosed with the Admit Card.
11. Examination centre will not take the responsibility for the loss or damage of any personal belongings.

IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS FOR CANDIDATES ON COVID-19

1. Candidates must maintain social distancing starting from point of entry in the exam venue till his/her exit from the exam venue.
2. Candidate must bring their own Mask, Gloves, personal hand sanitizer (50ml), transparent water Bottle, a simple pen and the exam related documents (Admit Card, ID Card etc.). No other items will be permitted inside exam venue.
3. A Candidate must have Aarogya Setu App installed on his mobile phone. The Aarogya Setu dashboard must show candidate's risk factor. A candidate will have to show this dashboard to the Security Guard at the entry into the exam venue. **THIS IS MANDATORY.** In case a candidate does not have a smart phone, he/she will have to bring in a signed declaration to this effect (declaration is provided along with the Admit Card) and show the same to the Security Guard at the entry into the exam venue.
4. Candidates showing COVID symptoms **WILL NOT** be allowed entry into the exam venue
5. Entry of Candidates will be given as per Time Slot given on Hall ticket to maintain Social Distancing at the Centre
6. Temperature of a candidates will be checked at the entry to the exam venue via a Thermo Gun. Only those candidates will be allowed inside the exam venue whose temperature is within the acceptability limits as approved by competent authorities.
7. Mapping of 'Candidate Roll Number and the Lab Number' will **NOT** be displayed outside the exam venue, but the same will be provided to the candidates individually at the time of entry of the candidate to the exam venue and post their Admit Card and ID verification.
8. Candidates needs to follow directions given by representatives & need to stand in the circles draw at the entry points
9. At registration desk, the candidate will be directed to sanitize his / her hands using provided sanitizer. Photograph will be captured during the registration process.
10. Candidates will be under CCTV coverage throughout the exam procedure.
11. Candidate is required to report at the exam venue strictly as per the time slot mentioned in the admit card **AND/OR** informed via SMS on their registered mobile number prior to exam date. It is expected that candidate strictly adhere

to this time slot – as entry into the test centre will be provided based upon the individual's time slot ONLY.
